III. Approval of Last Board Minutes

IV. Discussion Items

1. UIL & Student Activities Policies

Synopsis: Review of UIL compliance policies including concussion oversight appointments, student safety requirements, academic suspension for failing grades, and participation eligibility for military dependents and students under mental health treatment. Shubham Pandey presented to the Board the new House Bill items that have been added and we are basically making sure they are added to the agenda. UIL is used for inter-district sports as well as academic competitions. These items are required to comply with the student safety requirements listed above. Shubham Pandey asked the Board if they have any questions. There were no questions by the Board.

2. Student Health Curriculum Policy

Synopsis: Presentation of School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) recommendations on adoption of curriculum addressing human sexuality instruction, prevention of abuse/violence/trafficking, and parental notice procedures. Shubham Pandey presented the Student Health Curriculum Policy to the Board. This item came from the House Bill that we are required to adopt. There were no questions by the Board.

3. Security Officer Policy

Synopsis: Discussion of armed security staffing requirements, compliance with state law, and documentation of 'good cause exception if applicable. Shubham Pandey presented to the Board the Security Officer Policy. There are two campuses, Royse City Elementary and Beltline School – Mesquite elementary that used the good cause exemption three years back. The law requires every school to have their own security officers. We are applying for the good cause exemption waiver that will be requested to the Board for those two campuses. Victoria White questioned if all campuses had security officers. Shubham Pandey confirmed security officers at all campuses. There were no further questions from the Board.

4. Personal Communication Device Policy

Synopsis: Review of Superintendent's updated reporting requirements and policy data collection on violations, confiscations, and exceptions. Shubham Pandey presented to the Board the Personal Communication Device Policy. The State of Texas has banned personal communication devices from being used in school. We have to provide a report to Texas Education Agency if any violations are made. Victoria White questioned how would staff ensure students did not use their devices. Shubham Pandey informed the Board devices would be put in lock boxes for phones from a grant that would be forthcoming. There were no further questions by the Board.

5. Parental Engagement Policy

Synopsis: Discussion on framework for Internet parent portal access, meeting scheduling flexibility, and prioritization of public comments. Shubham Pandey presented to the Board the Parental Engagement Policy. This is the framework for providing internet access to parents to provide flexible meeting scheduling and prioritizing public comments based on the House Bill updates. There were no questions by the Board.

6. Concussion Response Policy (Non-Athletic)

Synopsis: Overview of new TEA guidance requiring return-to-activity protocols and academic accommodation processes following suspected concussions. Shubham Pandey presented to the Board the Concussion Response Policy (Non-Athletic). This policy comes directly from Texas Education Agency that has specific protocols and accommodations that are needed. There were no questions from the Board.

7. Board Training Guide – TOMA & TPIA Updates

Synopsis: Review of legislative changes to notice posting timelines, online publication of minutes, and public transparency obligations. Shubham Pandey presented to the Board the Board Training Guide – TOMA & TPIA Updates. Board responses to make sure that anything the Board replies to has to be a part of an agenda. We have a process for filing grievances. Anyone is welcome to make public comment. Board members cannot respond outside of the agenda item. This is essentially the review we already do. There were no questions from the Board.

8. Vendor Contract Restrictions (HB 210)

Synopsis: Informational update on new conflict-of-interest prohibitions for vendors and board members. Shubham Pandey presented to the Board the Vendor Contract Restrictions (HB 210). There is a conflict of interest policy to ensure there is no prohibition connected with the vendors of the Board members. There is no action required for this item.
