



PTAA Student Technology Use Agreement 2026–2027

Purpose

At PTAA, technology is a privilege that enhances your learning. By using a school-issued Chromebook, laptop, or iPad, you agree to follow the rules below.

Student Responsibilities

- Use your device for school-related activities only.
- Follow all PTAA rules from the Student Handbook while online or using devices.
- Treat your device with care, don't drop, write on, or damage it.
- No loaners will be issued for forgotten or misplaced devices.
- Report inappropriate messages or content to a teacher or administrator right away.

Parent Responsibilities

- ✓ Talk with your student about safe and respectful tech use.
- ✓ No app purchases are required beyond what the school provides.
- ✓ Set clear home rules for technology use and screen time.

School Responsibilities

- Provide filtered internet access on campus.
- Train students and staff in safe, effective tech use.

Prohibited Actions - Do Not:

- Tamper with device settings or jailbreak the Chromebook.
- Download unauthorized or inappropriate apps/media.
- Record others (including staff) without permission.
- Use chat rooms, messaging apps, games, or social media.
- Share personal info online or attempt to bypass web filters.
- Use the device for illegal, violent, offensive, or bullying content.



Device Care

- Don't decorate it.
- Avoid overstuffing backpacks and never leave devices unattended.
- Clean the screen with a soft cloth—no liquids.
- Never leave your device in extreme heat or direct sunlight.

Damage, Loss, or Theft

- Report any issues to the school within one day. Initial the following:
